INTRODUCTION

With growing demand, the need for more pilots is expected to grow in the years ahead to as many as 18,000 new hires annually.

- >> American Airlines' chief financial officer said he wants to hire a total of 2,000 pilots by the end of 2022, double the previous number of pilots they've ever hired in a year.
- >> To recruit new pilots, discount airline Avelo Airlines has begun offering \$20,000 sign-on bonuses.
- >> There have been calls to <u>raise the</u>
 retirement age from 65 to 67 as well as reduce
 the number of flight hours required for
 certification.
- >> Some airlines, like United Airlines and Alaska Airlines, have launched their own inhouse training programs to attract the next generation of pilots.

Phoenix-Mesa-Chandler, AZ is a hotspot for Software Developers. The national average for an area this size is 20,995* employees, while there are 28,134 here.



Compensation

The cost for talent is low in Phoenix-Mesa-Chandler, AZ. The national median salary for Software Developers is \$120,744, while you'll pay \$103,116



Postings Competition

Competition from online job postings is high in Phoenix-Mesa-Chandler, AZ. The national average for an area this size is 18,629* job postings annually, while there are 27,405 here.


*National average values are derived by taking the national value for Software Developers and scaling it down to account for the difference in overall workforce size between the nation and Phoenix-Mesa-Chandler, AZ. In other words, the values represent the national average adjusted for region size

The national median salary for airline pilots, copilots, and flight engineers is fairly high at \$202,180.

However, considering the cost for <u>education is</u> around \$100,000 and 1,500 minimum flight hours <u>are required</u> to earn an airline transport pilot (ATP) certificate, many are discouraged from pursuing these careers.




Nearly
